On the 22nd November 2022, the undersigned hereby affirm the spirit of an understanding based on mutual respect and faith and pledge to work harmoniously together for the common goal of community-outreach and have collaborative relationship in various social-service activities and welfare programs.

Rani Birla Girls' College, was established with a vision to serve as an ideal seat for young women learners of diverse socio- economic background, agrees to collaborate with Ankur Kala, a registered charity of Kolkata to venture into several social service activities to promote community outreach.

Whereas, Ankur Kala, a registered charity of Kolkata, whose mission is to work for the rehabilitation and empowerment of the marginalised and destitute, especially women and children, working in West Bengal, India, agrees to collaborate with Rani Birla Girls' College, an educational institute aiming for women empowerment and community outreach activities. The purpose of this collaboration is to support socially productive activities and to foster collaboration and work towards the common goal of societal welfare. Both the parties will collaborate in the following activities:

 socially productive activities/ welfare programs organised by the Ankur Kala permitting that the
 activities are feasible, keeping in consideration the distance and the academic schedules of the
 students/staff members of Rani Birla Girls' College.
- The students/staff members of Rani Birla Girls' College will organize different socially
 productive programs in college in which the organisation of Ankur Kala would set up stalls for
 sale of their products of Ankur Kala, as it was prevalent in previous sessions.
- The students/staff members of Rani Birla Girls' College will also try to participate in different 'social cause' drives and activities organised in joint collaboration with Ankur Kala.

The above collaboration will be functional from the date of signing, i.e. 22.11.2022 and it will be effective for two years. If this collaboration is found to be successful and both the party agrees, it will eventually culminate into Memorandum of Understanding at a later date. However, either of the parties would have the right to exit from this collaboration, citing reasons for so, if the collaboration becomes detrimental to its interest.
