MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is made on 05.08.2023 between Rani Birla Girls' College and Sammilani Mahavidyalaya for mutual cooperation witnesseth in academic exchanges, program development and research. This document establishes the guiding terms and principles of collaboration between the two organizations:

I. LEGAL FRAMEWORKS OF BOTH THE ORGANIZATIONS:

Rani Birla Girls' College, offering undergraduate courses and programmes to the girls of diverse ethnic origins and multi-linguistic culture and affiliated to the University of Calcutta, represented by its Principal, Dr. Srabanti Bhattacharya hereinafter referred to as the FIRST PARTY (which term or expression shall unless excluded by or repugnant to the context be deemed to mean and include its successor in office, representatives, administrators, and assigns)

Sammilani Mahavidyalaya, established in 1996 and offering undergraduate courses and programmes to the students hailing from southern part ok Kolkata and South 24 Parganas and to the affiliated to the University of Calcutta, and Government of West Bengal aided college, represented by its Principal, Dr. Chandan Kumar Jana hereinafter referred to as the SECOND PARTY (which term or expression shall unless excluded by or repugnant to the context be deemed to mean and include its successor in office, representatives, administrators, and assigns). Both these organizations will be hereafter referred to as Parties.

II. PURPOSE OF THE AGREEMENT

Both the Parties are pleased to enter upon an agreement to establish ties of academic cooperation in order to contribute to the achievement of their overall goals as institutions of higher education through following but not limited to:

- 1. Joint teaching-learning and internship
- 2. Collaboration in the area of research, publications, project work, etc.
- 3. Joint field trip, excursion, and education tour
- 4. Joint training, add-on, certificate and vocational courses.
- 5. Joint extension activities, consultancy
- 6. Joint faculty and staff development programmes



- Co-hosting and participation in conferences, seminars, symposiums, and workshops, book fairs etc.
- 8. Sporting and cultural programs
- 9. Any other activity that is mutually agreed upon and is beneficial to both.

III. TERM AND EXPIRATION OF THE AGREEMENT

This agreement will come into effect after being signed by both Parties and will be established for a period of five years. After these five years it will be automatically extended for same period, unless one of the Parties expresses an intention (by written notification) to cancel the agreement at least 90 days before the expiry date. The amendment, termination and expiration of this MoU will not affect the terms of activities ongoing at the time of notification of amendment, termination, or expiration, unless otherwise agreed upon between the Parties.

Any additions, changes, or deletions to this document must be approved by the representatives of both Parties. All notices shall be in writing and shall be directed to these representatives.

IV. FREE TO EXIT:

Either of the parties would have the liberty to exit the agreement – citing reasons for so – if the linkage becomes untenable for any reason whatsoever.

V. NON- FINANCIAL IMPLICATION:

The linkage will not have any financial implication on either college.

VI. NON-EXCLUSIVITY:

This Agreement is a non-exclusive agreement, and both parties remain free to enter into similar agreements with third parties.

VII. SPECIAL PROVISIONS

- Each party will take approval from the other party in writing prior to using the latter's name and logo for the activities hereunder on a case-by-case basis.
- 2. All parties hereto shall do their utmost to ensure the smooth and efficient implementation of the programs.
- The parties will consult with each other for any subsequent associated agreement informally and attempt to resolve disputes or misunderstandings that may arise in the administration of this MoU or any subsequent associated agreement informally.

VIII. DISPUTES

If any dispute arises in respect of the MoU, in that case both the organisations will discuss and settle the matter amicably.
