

## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BY AND BETWEEN

VIDYASAGAR COLLEGE FOR WOMEN 39, SANKAR GHOSH LANE KOLKATA-06, WEST BENGAL, INDIA

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is made on ..... between Rani Birla Girls' College and Vidyasagar College for Women for cooperation witnesseth in academic exchanges, program development and research. This document establishes the guiding terms and principles of collaboration between the two organizations:

Legal Frameworks of Both the Organizations

Rani Birla Girls' College, affiliated to the University of Calcutta and Government of West Bengal aided college, represented by its Principal, Dr. Srabanti Bhattacharya hereinafter referred to as the FIRST PARTY (which term or expression shall unless excluded by or repugnant to the context be deemed to mean and include its successor in office, representatives, administrators, and

Vidyasagar College for Women, affiliated to the University of Calcutta, and Government of West Bengal aided college, represented by its Principal Dr. Sutapa Ray , hereinafter referred to as the SECOND PARTY (which term or expression shall unless excluded by or repugnant to the context be deemed to mean and include its successor in office, representatives, administrators, and assigns). Both these organizations will be hereafter referred to as Parties.

Purpose of the Agreement

Both the Parties are pleased to enter upon an agreement to establish ties of academic cooperation in order to contribute to the achievement of their overall goals as institutions through following but not limited to:

Joint teaching and research projects. 1.

- Collaboration in the area of academic publications, research activities, 2. field trips etc.
- Visit, training and exchange of faculty, staff, and students 3.

Joint educational/vocational courses. 4.

Joint consultancy, PhD. supervision, scientific publications. 5.

- Co-hosting and participation in conferences, seminars, symposiums, and 6. workshops, book fairs etc.
- Social and cultural programs 7.

Sporting activities 8.

Any other activity that is mutually agreed upon and is beneficial to both. 9.



Term and Expiration of the Agreement 111.

It is understood that this agreement will come into effect after being signed by both Parties and will be established for a period of five years. After these five years it will be automatically extended for same period, unless one of the Parties expresses an intention (by written notification) to cancel the agreement at least 90 days before the expiry date. The amendment, termination and expiration of this MoU will not affect the terms of activities ongoing at the time of notification of amendment, termination, or expiration, unless otherwise agreed upon between the Parties.

Any additions, changes, or deletions to this document must be approved by the representatives of both Parties. All notices shall be in writing and shall be directed to these representatives.

#### IV. NON-EXCLUSIVITY:

This Agreement is a non-exclusive agreement, and both parties remain free to enter into similar agreements with third parties.

#### ٧. SPECIAL PROVISIONS

- Each party will take approval from the other party in writing prior to using the latter's name and logo for the activities hereunder on a case-by-case basis.
- 2. All parties hereto shall do their utmost to ensure the smooth and efficient implementation of the programs.
- 3. The parties will consult with each other for any subsequent associated agreement informally and attempt to resolve disputes or misunderstandings that may arise in the administration of this MoU or any subsequent associated agreement informally.

### DISPUTES

If any dispute arises in respect of the MoU, in that case both the organisations will discuss and settle the matter amicably.
