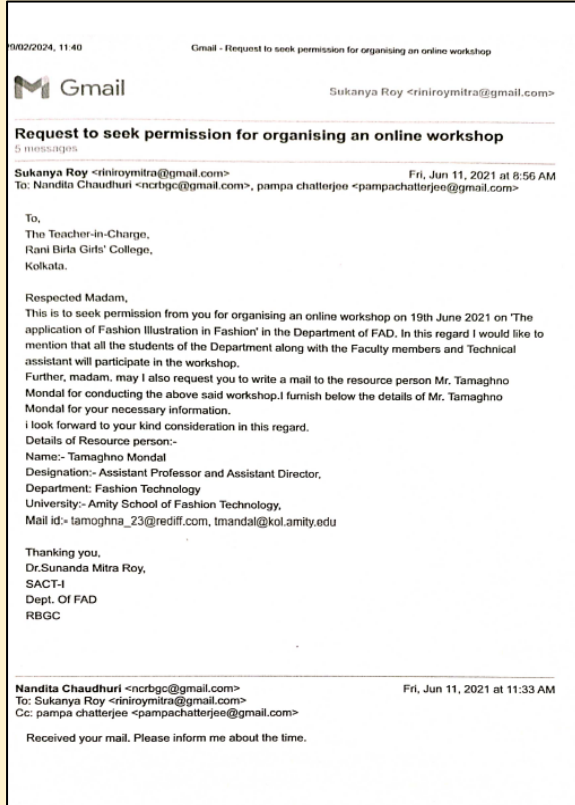



BY DEPARTMENT OF FASHION AND APPAREL DESIGN

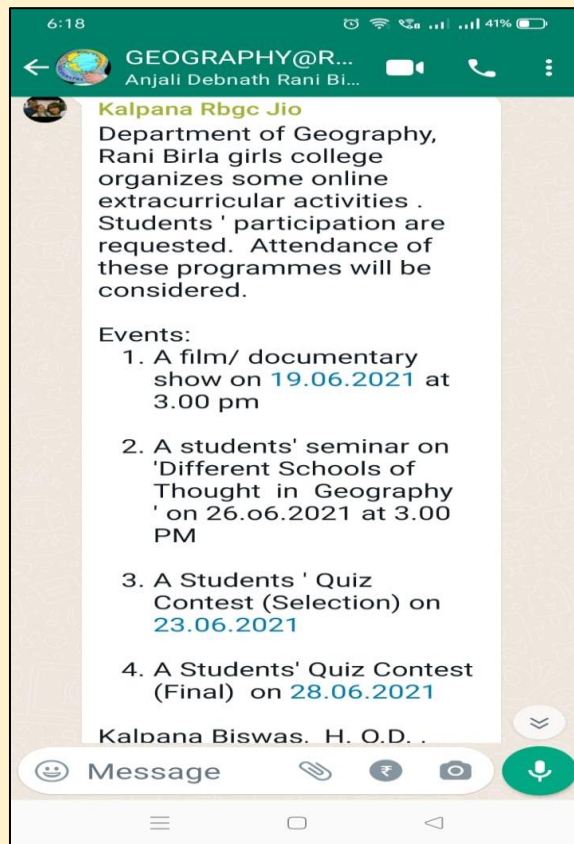
FOR ACADEMIC SESSION 2020-2021
